Project 73 is based in Bracknell Forest and is a social group for adults between the age of 18 and 35 on the Autistic spectrum who require minimal or no support from social care.

This social group setting provides activities and peer support that helps to develop self-advocacy skills, opportunities to make friends and much more.

Activities are always based on the group's choices and then sent out as a monthly calendar of events.

All attendees pay for their activity and there is a £2 fee for attending which covers staff costs.

We have attended events such as Comic-Con, gaming days and festivals and are looking forward to attending many more events together. Project 73 has a Facebook page where a monthly calendar of events and information on our other activities are posted.







Project 73 Plus is the next step from Project 73 and is aimed at adults over 30 on the Autistic spectrum.

We meet on the First Wednesday of every month at South Hill Park Atrium bar from 7pm - 9pm.

South Hill Park is located in Bracknell and the postcode is RG12 7PA.

There is a £2 fee for attending which covers staff costs.
